Clothing:

Please ensure that you always wear suitable items of clothing on the water. This is for your own comfort as well as your safety.

Cotton items of clothing are not suitable because they retain water which will make you cold as well as making your clothing heavy when you swim. The following items are suitable:

- wet shoes/boots (essential)
- swimwear
- wet suit, if you possess one
- thermal vest or t-shirt made of synthetic material
- thermal leggings or joggers made of synthetic material
- man-made fleece jumper
- waterproof jacket or cagoule
- dry change of clothes for end of session
- large towel

Ideally you should have a minimum of 2 layers under a waterproof jacket – remember it can be very cold and windy on the river; the club has waterproof jackets that you may borrow.

Please ask if you are not sure whether something is suitable to wear.

Personal Hygiene:

Please ensure that all cuts and open wounds are covered with a water proof dressing to prevent infection. You should also shower or bathe after each river session and before eating or drinking to reduce the risk of contracting Weil's disease or other waterborne illnesses.

Weil's disease is an extremely rare but serious illness which can be caught by touching soil or water contaminated with the urine of animals such as rats infected with the leptospira bacteria. The common signs of Weil's disease are flu like symptoms. If you suffer from flu like symptoms please inform your G.P. that you have been taking part in paddlesports on the river.
